Re: Water Use and Conservation Summer of 2021

Eagle County has been in extreme drought since August 2020. A much drier than normal summer and fall contributed to low streamflow and dry soils. It is very likely that watershed conditions will remain dry this summer, and streamflow's will be low. Your water use is directly linked to stream levels; when stream flows are low, high water use compounds the negative impact on local streams.

As a reminder, in Red Sky Ranch the outside watering schedule is based on the last number of your street address. Outside watering must occur before 9 a.m. or after 5 p.m.:

- Even address: Sunday, Wednesday, and Friday
- Odd address: Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday
- THERE IS NO OUTSIDE WATER USE ON MONDAYS

We are asking our property owners to assess their water use and take steps to reduce the amount of water used. In an effort to encourage conservation, the Board will be considering an increase in the top tier water rates, which are those above 25,000 gallons per month, at their June 21<sup>st</sup> board meeting. Making changes now will prepare your property and landscaping for dry summer conditions and help make such reductions permanent for the future, which will also lower your bill. New rates being considered are:
